

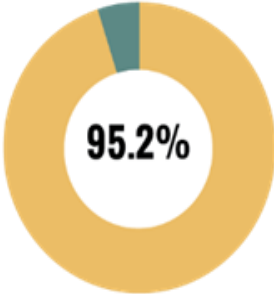

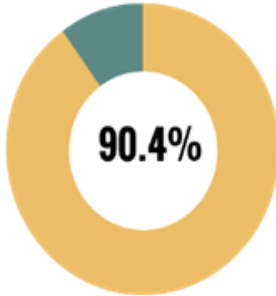


Arizona Public Water Systems By System Type

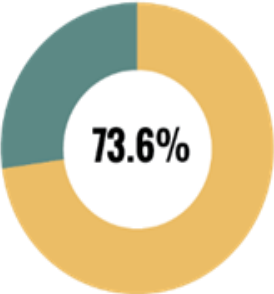
There are 1,502 PWSs in Arizona. We work primarily with small PWSs.



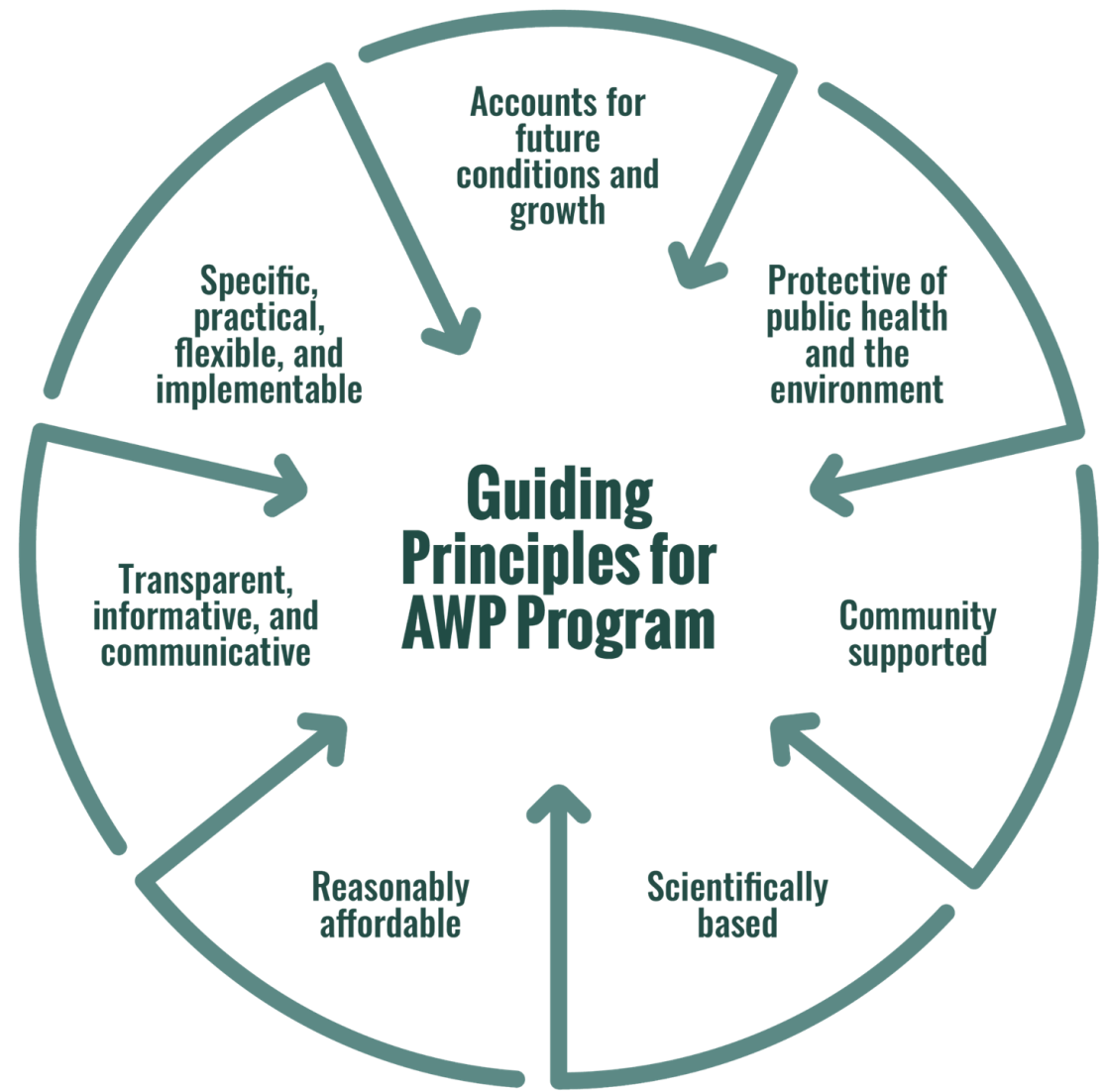
1,430 systems (95.2%) are considered "small" – serving less than 10,000 people



1,358 systems (90.4%) serve fewer than 3,300 people



1,106 systems (73.6%) serve fewer than 500 people
