### **Must include:**

- Title
- Objectives/Summary
- Mini-Bio (contact info., school and degree being pursued, photo)
- References Make sure that your advisor/supervisor/co-authors sign off on your abstract before submission
- Images (make it presentable!)

### To Note:

- Deadline to submit topic summary (100-200 words) is <u>January 5<sup>th</sup></u>, <u>2020</u>.
- Only 10 poster topics will be chosen to be presented at the conference.
   \*Selected poster contest participants will receive a complimentary conference registration, free yearly student membership to EPAZ & a certificate
- Free printing shall be provided if the poster is digitally submitted to Tara Thurman (contact info. below) by February 12<sup>th</sup>, 2020. After the deadline, students would be required to print their own posters on foam core board (approx. 36"x48")
