

# Vegetation Harvests at Sierrita

- Began in 2018 as a result of direct engagement with elected leaders from the Nation's San Xavier District
- 11 harvests
  - 4 in 2021
  - 1 in 2022
  - 1 in 2023
- Culturally significant species
- Mesquite wood, ocotillo, wild tobacco, various cacti and wildflowers, etc.
- Some are consumed; many are transplanted (San Xavier Co-op Farm nursery)


